Iowa Pilots and Student Pilots:

In 2007, Iowa Aviation Promotion Group launched ***Flight Iowa Challenge 2007***. Several dozen pilots and non-pilots participated and visited airports throughout Iowa during the period of May 1, 2007 to September 30, 2007. The 2007 top winners visited all 115 Iowa public airports and some private public use airports as well.

In the spirit of continuing the IAPG mission of growing aviation, stimulating pilot activity, and providing some friendly competition, the IAPG Board extended ***Fly Iowa Challenge*** to 2008 as well as into 2009 and beyond! This letter explains present rules updates to make it even easier to participate in the ***Fly Iowa Challenge!***

- The contest will begin when the participant pays the entry fee and receives the ***Fly Iowa Challenge Passport***. Registration can be accomplished on-line by visiting www.flyiowa.org and entry fee and IAPG membership can be paid on-line by PayPal or downloading and mailing the application and entry fee to IAPG. Currently, there are 108 public airports.
- There is now no time limitation to participate in the ***Fly Iowa Challenge*** and qualify for awards and prizes. The only stipulation is that you must be registered for the ***Fly Iowa Challenge*** (and thus automatically a member of Iowa Aviation Promotion Group) for an airport visit to count and logged in the ***Fly Iowa Challenge Passport***.
- Registered participants will be given a ***Fly Iowa Challenge Passport*** in which to record airport visits. Iowa Aviation Promotion Group will reserve the right to verify passport entries against the participant's official FAA Pilot's Log.

Enclosed is the complete package explaining the ***Fly Iowa Challenge***. We hope you accept the challenge and that you will have lots of fun along the way. More information is available on our website, www.flyiowa.org.

Fly Iowa Challenge Rules – Effective 2011 and Reviewed Jan 2019

The purpose of this contest is to challenge Iowa's pilots to visit Iowa's 108 public use airports and at least one of Iowa's Aviation museums. The Fly Iowa Challenge is open to pilots age 16 and up and you need not be an Iowa Resident to participate,

Why are we doing this?

- **Increase the awareness of and promote Iowa's excellent system of public airports.**
- **Increase the level of flying at Iowa's airports.**
- **Increase the activity and proficiency of Iowa's pilots.**
- **Increase support for the goals of Iowa Aviation Promotion Group.**

Fly Iowa Challenge Rules for Pilots

- **You must be 16 years old as of date of registration for this contest. Pilots under age 18 must have parent or guardian permission.**
- **There is no time limit to participate in the Fly Iowa Challenge and qualify for awards and prizes. The only stipulation is that you must be registered for the FIC and thus maintain membership in Iowa Aviation Promotion Group while you are counting and logging visits to Iowa Airports. IAPG reserves the right to verify your passport entries against your FAA logbook. A landing, at least a touch and go, constitutes an airport visit. Full stops are encouraged. In the event there are safety or aircraft performance considerations which make a fly-in visit unwise, a drive-in visit or fly-over may be substituted.**
- **Your payment of the \$25 registration fee (includes IAPG Participating membership) entitles you to log airport visits for**

contest purposes. Only visits after registration and while you are maintaining contest registration and IAPG membership will count.

Fly Iowa Challenge 2015 and Beyond

Participation Rewards



Platinum Level - participant must visit all Iowa airports & two museums while maintaining registration in **Fly Iowa Challenge**.

Reward: Platinum level participant will receive a personalized leather A-2 jacket with the **Fly Iowa Challenge** winner patch and their name placed on the recognition plaque at the Iowa Aviation Museum at Greenfield.



Gold Level - participant must visit 50 Iowa airports & one museum while maintaining registration in **Fly Iowa Challenge**.

Reward: Gold level participant will receive a flight bag with their initials embroidered on it and the **Fly Iowa Challenge** winner patch.



Silver Level - participant must visit 25 Iowa airports while maintaining registration in **Fly Iowa Challenge**.

Reward: Silver level participant will receive choice of shirt (polo or button-up front) with the **Fly Iowa Challenge** winner patch.



Bronze Level - participant must visit 25 Iowa airports. This level is designed for student pilots.

Reward: Bronze level participant will receive hat with **Fly Iowa Challenge** participant patch.
