- Open to ages 16-24 at the time of submitting application.
- Completed Applications are due **April 1st** and valid for one year.
- Recipients of this Scholarship will be recognized at IAPG's annual members meeting, in various IAPG media announcements and possibly in media outlets.
- Special emphasis will be placed on motivation and level of need.
- Any information deemed false or invalid will be grounds for ineligibility.

Application Instructions:

Applicants will:

1. Complete the IAPG Application form (See below);
2. Write an essay describing your goals in aviation and how you plan to reach them. Essay is limited to one page;
3. Submit two letters of recommendation from persons who know you and can attest to your character and ambitions in aviation, may be written using company letterhead;
4. Include copy of current FAA Airman Medical Certificate (form 8500-9).
